## Grantchester

### Red Wines

125ml 175ml 250ml 750ml

#### Tierra del Rey Merlot 2008

£3.10 £3.50 £4.60 £13.95

A little more, ripe blackberry and plum aromas on the nose are complimented by hints of spice and black pepper. The palate is succulent, soft and fruity, beautifully balanced by velvet-textured tannins.

#### Hidden Rock Petit Verdot - Cabernet Sauvignon 2008

£3.35 £3.75 £4.95 £14.95

A full flavoured blend of 80% Petit Verdot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine has a good deep colour and ripe flavours of raspberries and blackcurrants.

#### Philippe de Rothschild Pinot Noir 2008 VdP d'Oc

£3.75 £4.10 £5.45 £16.50

The wine, a deep red with a violet tint, has a rich, well-developed nose, full of fruit, dominated by black cherry mingled with refined and delicate violet scents. Round and full on the palate, it combines a well-integrated structure and delicious mouth feel.

#### Castillo la Paz 2006 Tempranillo, La Mancha

£3.65 £4.00 £5.35 £16.00

Juicy and tempting red fruits, all very primary with a nice lick of oak. Rioja look-alike but from the upcoming area of La Mancha, therefore very nicely priced. Always a massive hit on tasting.

#### William Robertson Pinotage 2009 Robertson

£18.50

The great estate in Franschoek produces ripe plush wines. This Pinotage is bursting with plum, banana and berry aromas follow through to a juicy, medium- to full-bodied palate. An recognisably welcome style for those who love the Pinotage style.

#### Santa Rosa Malbec 2006

£19.00

Malbec is the sharper cousin of Merlot making it an ideal food wine with rich sauces and strong flavours. Ruby garnet in colour this wine has plenty of grip and is warm and welcoming in the mouth.

#### Ch. La Grande Clotte 2005 Lussac St Emilion

£23.50

Arguably the most renowned wines on earth, here based on Cabernet Sauvignon, both Merlot and Cabernet Franc play important roles in adding layered complexity to the finished wine. An elegant balance of ripe fruits, minerality and structure with a rich blackberry core and supple feel.

#### Vina Indomita Duette Pinot Noir Casablanca Valley

£23.50

Sourced from vines grown in the Alta Maipo region, close to Santiago, Duette Pinot Noir is a premium wine that displays a silky texture, good structure and hints of violets and vanilla. This is really a region to watch for cooler climate reds as well as the well proven success of the whites.

#### Ch. Rousseau de Sipian 2005 Medoc

£25.50

A wine of serious intent with a deep cassis flavour and lovely spice generated from the oak ageing. Clean, fresh aromas of appetising red fruits with undertones of cedar and liquorice. A classic style of claret with ripe blackcurrants and cherries beneath an elegant oak embrace.

## Morgon 2009 Cave de Bel Air, Burgundy

£26.95

A typically ripe and opulent vintage for Beaujolais, this warm spicy Gamay also has plenty of bubblegum, strawberry and raspberry sweet fruit in the mid pallet making it a perfect lunchtime tipple for the warmer weather.

## Vacqueyras Les Christins 2007 Dom. Perrin

£29.50

A real blockbuster is the 2007 Vacqueyras Les Cristins, a blend of 80% Grenache and 20% Syrah. Its deep ruby/purple hue is followed by a full-bodied bouquet of black cherries, black currants, liquorice, grilled herbs, and roasted meats.

## Dom. Gayda Figure Libre Cabernet Franc 2009 VdP d'Oc Rouge

£35.00

Opaque, perfumed with fragrant black cherry and cassis. Full bodied, intense with countless layers of flavour including blackcurrant, cedar and graphite. Dense fruit on the palate is bound by a structure of fine grained tannins and a lively acidity.

## **Rosé Wines**

**125ml 175ml 250ml 750ml**

### Wildwood Zinfandel Rosé, California

£3.10 £3.50 £4.60 £13.95

Made using the ripest grapes in the region to produce a youthful fruity wine with aromas of fresh cherries and watermelon. Flavours of juicy ripe strawberries and sweet pear drops make this a delicious and moreish medium pallet wine suitable for those of a sweeter disposition.

### Pinot Grigio Blush Delle Venezie 2007 La Delfina

£3.45 £3.85 £5.10 £15.50

Light fresh and dry with a gentle soft pink hue this wine is great for the lighter palate and will refresh the thirstiest Pinot Grigio fan and delight with a touch of class.

### Santa Digna Cabernet Sauvignon Rosé 2009

£4.20 £4.60 £6.10 £18.50

Fragrant and floral, with a temptingly fruity sensuality, this wine is voluptuous, with a silky texture and a firm, fresh, fruity body. The forward fruit tricks the mind into thinking of sweetness but don't be fooled, this is a great alcoholic fruit bomb!

## **Sparkling Wines**

### Val d'Oca Prosecco Extra Dry 2009

£18.50

A terrific sparkling wine with an elegant floral bouquet and a magnificent mousse. It has the perfect balance between acidity and softness.

### Portaceli Cava Brut NV

£17.95

Finally a Cava worth the money! So sadly de-valued in supermarkets over the last few years Cava has been suffering from a serious quality drought but we finally found a very decent one after much searching. Dry and light with a beautifully soft mousse this is simply delicious.

### Cava Portaceli Rosado NV (Sparkling Rose)

Glass £4.95 £17.95

Add a touch of Pink to your day with this delightful light and fruity Cava. Subtle hints of strawberry on the nose with a creamy satisfying finish.

### Silvola Rosato NV Bartolomeo Breganze (Sparkling Rose)

£23.00

Floral notes of acacia and rose lay on top of hints of ripe apple, pear and white peach. In the mouth the wine is fresh, harmonious, fruity with strawberry notes, dry and well balanced.

### Champagnes

#### Pierre Bertrand Brut 1er Cru NV

£35.00

Blind tasting winner for the Trinity May Ball Champagne, beating all the ones you know. Tiny house in the famous village of Cumieres in the Marne valley. Pinot-dominated like most wines from this village, it's pale copper/gold and wonderfully peachy and lush, explosively juicy, and cracking value.

#### Joseph Perrier Brut NV Cuvee Royale

£45.00

Quite simply the best value Grand Marque champagne, and the one which everyone loves. Rich fruity style, with finesse and gentle biscuit finish. Mature, mellow and ripe, with a touch of earthy spice. Plump, medium-weight fruit. Ideal Champagne for large parties as it will satisfy the bready and the fruity pallets that often divide Champagne drinkers.

#### Pol Roger White Foil Brut NV Reserve

£60.00

Brilliant champagne from the family-owned Pol Roger champagne house. This elegant champagne, which was favoured by Sir Winston Churchill and the British Royal family, is still family owned and operated. It's a rich Pinot Noir-dominated champagne with a fine mousse and thanks to extra bottle age has a lovely roundness, which our English palate appreciates.

### White Wines

#### Tierra del Rey Sauvignon Blanc 2009

£3.10 £3.50 £4.60 £13.95

This Sauvignon Blanc offers tropical fruit aromas with delicate hints of scented white flowers and gooseberry. Vibrant and refreshing with ripe citrus and tropical fruit flavours balanced by a crisp, clean finish - perfect on its own or as an accompaniment to seafood or salad lunches.

#### Hidden Rock Colombard, Chardonnay, Vedelho 2009

£3.35 £3.75 £4.95 £14.95

White fleshed peach and nectarine with lime and citrus through the mid palate, finishing with a touch of honeysuckle and orange blossom. Pale straw hue, the nose displays peach and stone fruits, with a hint of citrus and orange blossom. The palate has lingering fresh fruit flavours with balanced acid.

#### Aloe Tree Chenin Blanc 2009, Robertson

£3.45 £3.85 £5.10 £15.50

A delightfully crisp, fruit driven white with hints of green apple and pear on the nose. Bright, juicy fruit on the palate with a tangy, refreshing finish.

#### Philippe de Rothschild Viognier 2007/8 Vin de Pays D'Oc

£16.95

Rich, juicy fruit and slightly off dry with typical aromas of peach and rose petal. Hints of tarragon and anise on the palate, full texture, great with herbed salads or as a quaffer.

#### Pinot Grigio Delle Venezie 'Fiorile' 2007/8 Cesari

£3.85 £4.25 £5.60 £16.95

A delightfully light and grassy style of Pinot Grigio. Soft yet crisp, with an indescribable, almost creamy, texture so common in good Italian whites. Great values for a premium Pinot Grigio, let curiosity get the better of you!

### Campo Flores Verdejo Sauvignon Blanc Organic VdT Castilla

£17.95

Vivacious, tangy and ripe. Made from organically grown grapes picked in the cool of the night to retain their vibrant fruit character. Deliciously dry and fragrant, this youthful white is ideal as an aperitif or with shellfish and salads.

### Macon-Villages 2007/8 Cave de Lugny

£18.95

A classic Mâcon-Village, this is what southern white Burgundy is all about: clean and fresh Chardonnay fruit flavours without descending into over-oaky, sugary cartoon wines. Citrus fruit and spring meadows feature on the nose, whilst the palate displays more lemon flavours with a touch of tangerine.

### Mirror Lake Sauvignon Blanc 2009 Marlborough

£19.95

Hand picked from a blind tasting of New Zealand Sauvignons this example shows all of the vibrancy and flavour of some of the most expensive on the market. Cut grass and gooseberries with elderflower overtones.

### Gavi 2008 DOCG, Camporosso, Piemonte

£21.50

One of Italy's most fashionable whites, it is noted for acute dryness and fresh, flinty acidity. This is a bright straw-yellow wine with greenish highlights. It has a full, delicate, elegant bouquet that brings flowers and fresh fruit to mind - mostly lemons, lily of the valley and green apples.

### Chablis 2008 J.M Brocard

£25.50

This is the most complex and vibrant wine from the Préhy vineyard. The subtle mineral character of its youth will develop into a fuller and more powerful style. Brilliant colour with green highlights. The nose is precise, pure, chiselled, with slightly iodised notes of citrus fruit. The mouth has a classic structure, crunchy and delicious, with notes of citrus fruit, minerality and salty touches.

### Sancerre 2009 Dom. Sautereau, Loire Valley France

£29.95

The talented David Santereau provides this single-estate Sancerre from family vineyards in the village of Crézancy-en-Sancerre. This highly sought-after provenance is boosted by the excellent 2009 vintage, which adds a juicy ripeness to notes of benchmark smoky terroir. Fresh, zesty flavours, evocative of ripe thick-skinned gooseberries which typify quality Sancerre, makes this a delicious aperitif

### Pouilly Fumé 2008 Dom. de Bel Air

£32.50

The classic "cuvée", harmony of our different soils, in symbiosis, with finesse and aromatic intensity well balanced with full and fruity mouth and a very persistent and lively finish. The freshness and fruitiness will make it a perfect match for your shellfish, fish, goat-cheese, sea food and it is perfect as an aperitif.
